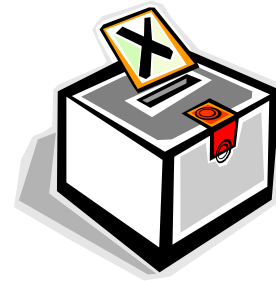

**Don't Forget...YOU CAN GET YOUR  
NATIONAL DUES WAIVED!!**

NALS members that sign up five NEW members within a 12 month period, beginning November 1st, will get their national dues waived for the year (this excludes state and local dues). The five new memberships must be in the same category of membership as the waived member, for example if you are a regular member who pays \$98 national dues then you must sign up five new members in that same category. The new members must report you as their sponsor when they submit their application to NALS and you must fill out the waiver that COMES IN your renewal notice when your Dues are due. On the waiver form you will indicate all five NEW members by name that you sponsored and submit it back to NALS. As long as everything matches up and all five new members have been acquired within a 12 month period then your national dues will be waived for the year and you will only be required to pay your state and local dues along with submitting the completed waiver form. **This Campaign begins November 1, 2009 and will run for a minimum of two years.**

This October, in the tradition of NALS providing a service to the communities it serves, it will be supporting the Mountain Country Homes of Hope's ReBuilding Hope Program in Branson, Missouri. [www.mchh.net](http://www.mchh.net). NALS will be collecting gift cards from Home Depot and Lowe's, VISA gift cards, cash and checks (made payable to MCHH) at the conference in Branson.

The donations will be presented to Mountain Country Homes of Hope during the weekend of October 21-23. Donations are tax-deductible. See below for more details about this worthwhile cause. Thank you, in advance, for all your donations for this charity!

What is ReBuilding Hope? ReBuilding Hope's purpose is to offer home maintenance or repair assistance to homeowners who are either seniors and veterans living on a fixed income or working, low-income families. While Homes of Hope continues to address decent and affordable home ownership, over the past few years we have found that there is a great and growing need to address home maintenance concerns as well; especially among the elderly and working, low-income families.

Projects are capped at \$5,000.00, but most requests are much smaller such as: cleaning gutters, caulking windows, constructing a handicap ramp, replacing a sink, toilet, door, winterizing pipes, roof repair, etc. We provide labor and materials for minor repairs/maintenance at no cost. For large repairs, however, if an applicant has the ability to make small, monthly payments we ask them to do so. Similar to repaying for a home through Homes of Hope, repayment enables us to help more people and empowers the ones receiving help to help others as well.

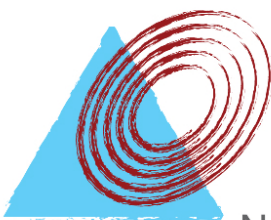

**Entry Deadline is November 1st – Submit Your Programs Today!**

The NALS Foundation is pleased to sponsor the NALS Jett Awards. Established in 1994, and named after NALS founder, Eula Mae Jett, the Jett Awards is an annual competition in which states and chapters outline their successful programs and submit them for review by an Awards Committee. The Jett Awards program was developed with a two-fold purpose in mind. First to recognize the “best of the best” programs throughout NALS; and second, to provide a resource of proven successful program guidelines for other states and chapters to emulate and adapt for their own use.

**Has Your State or Chapter Implemented a Successful Program?** Then submit your program to be considered for a Jett Award. All entries are classified first by association type/size. To maintain a level playing field, NALS states and chapters compete against other states and like-sized chapters. The categories are: State – programs or campaigns done exclusively by state associations; Large chapter – Programs or campaigns conducted by chapters with more than 51 members; Medium chapter – Programs or campaigns conducted by chapters with 26 to 50 members; and Small chapter – Programs or campaigns conducted by chapters with 25 or fewer members.

In addition, programs are categorized in eight general areas, and are evaluated against other like programs. The eight categories are: (1) Membership Development; (2) Association Development; (3) Association Enterprises; (4) CLE One-Time Program; (5) CLE Series of Related Topics; (6) ALS Certification Program; (7) PLS Certification Program; and (8) Certification Programs.

## Recap of Region 6 Meeting Pearl, Mississippi – July 17, 2010

Director Tina Hurley welcomed everyone in attendance and recognized those members of the host committee in attendance. There were approximately 40 members in attendance with several first timers.

The Director gave the current financial report and estimated income and expenses from this conference. There was much discussion on how to distribute the estimated profits and the Director reported on how it was done previously. Many options were discussed and those members in attendance decided the following: 50/50 split with the hosting state and it was decided that the Region's half would be distributed as follows:

\$500 to the Foundation

\$125 to each of the remaining states (AR, OK, MO, TX)

*(Note: TX members in attendance voted to decline the distribution)*

Remaining funds to remain in the Region 6 account

*[Note: After returning home and reviewing the income/expenses from the conference and discussion with the conference chair, an email was sent to the registered attendees with an update on the actual amount in the checking account. Donating the additional \$500 would leave the account at a very low balance, so the members were asked to vote on whether to give the additional \$500 to the Foundation. The majority vote was to keep the \$500 in the account for now.]* Once all income and expenses are received and paid, the Director will provide an update in Branson for further discussion.

Options were provided for the members to review for the 2011 Region 6 Conference to be hosted by Texas ALP. Amarillo sent in information regarding the hotel they had contacted along with a dinner at the River Breaks Ranch and the optional event on Saturday to visit Palo Duro Canyon and see the outdoor play "Texas." The members in attendance voted to go to Amarillo next year. More details will be provided at a later date.

After announcements, the meeting was adjourned.

Participation on a NALS committee will enhance your personal goals and professional growth, plus give you a clearer understanding of the inner workings of NALS.

Most of the NALS committees hold monthly meetings in the NALS Online Learning Center and communicate with each other via e-mail, an economical and “green” way to function as a committee. Though not mandatory, the national committees are encouraged to meet at the Professional Development Conference in March (March 10-12, 2011) and at the National Forum in Cincinnati, Ohio (October 13-16, 2011).

It is thrilling and exciting to be part of the NALS Leadership Team. You will have FUN getting to know other NALS members from around the country and will gain a sense of pride and accomplishment seeing your work come to fruition. **Accept the challenge to make a difference!**

@Law: This committee oversees the publication of NALS’ quarterly magazine and the monthly publication, e-Learn@NALS, a part of The NALS docket. The committee’s responsibilities include identifying and securing suitable authors for articles, proofreading articles, proofreading full magazine text, and preparing monthly editions of e-Learn@NALS.

Certifying Board: This committee consists of at least nine NALS members who serve for at least two years and who must be a PP or PLS in good standing. Two non-NALS members also serve on the Certifying Board. Although a PLS may fall under the category of “voluntary

recertification,” she or he must recertify in order to serve on the Certifying Board. In order to receive exam-related training (including statistics and exam preparation), it is imperative that during the two-year term Certifying Board members are available to attend each Professional Development conference held in Tulsa in March. Members of the Certifying Board are prevented from teaching any subject related to the certification exams while on the Certifying Board and for two years after their term expires. The Certifying Board is responsible for all issues directly related to the certification exams.

Education: This committee provides educational programs for NALS members, including legal training courses and certification study materials. There are two subcommittees that fall under the Education Committee umbrella: (1) the Education Products subcommittee is responsible for preparing and updating Mock Exams and Resource Manuals for various NALS certifications; and (2) the WebEd subcommittee is responsible for the topics and speakers for NALS webinar programs throughout the year. Some of the projects the Education Committee is responsible for include: arranging for education and professional development track sessions and speakers at the Professional Development Conference; arranging for education speakers at the National Forum; coordinating the Online Learning Center topics and the Online Study Group, as well as the NALS CLE Award, and Basic and Advanced Legal Training Courses.

Future Leader Development: This committee is in its second year and its responsibilities include providing seminars and programs via webinars, the Online Learning Center, or other venues specifically geared toward instructing and cultivating the future leaders of NALS.

Marketing: This committee is responsible for coordinating The NALS docket. This electronic magazine style newsletter includes information about topics covered on legal blogs and twitter, along with industry related articles and association news directly from the Resource Center Staff! E-Learn and Leading the Way are now part of The NALS docket. Marketing also coordinates E-News, the weekly newsletter sent to NALS members via email. Promotion of the various NALS programs is key. The Marketing Committee assists with the promotion of the NALS Award of Excellence, sponsors the Jett Awards, which showcase state and chapter achievements, promotes the professional development and national forum conferences, and is responsible for the NALS marketing blog and other programs to promote public awareness of NALS.

Membership: This committee’s responsibilities include assisting state and local membership chairs in recruitment and retention of NALS members. The Membership Committee promotes membership in this multi-level association, prepares and reviews all membership brochures and materials, promotes student membership, and promotes diversity in the membership of NALS. New to the Membership Committee is the Young Leader Professional subcommittee which tackles the issues and concerns of the young professional in the legal industry.

Regulation/Certification Committee: This committee monitors regulatory activity across the country and keeps NALS members up to date on what various states are doing in the regulation arena. Regulatory activity means either state legislation or rules proposed or adopted by state bar associations or state courts that would regulate how legal support professionals do their jobs, and in some instances who may work in a position with a certain title, such as paralegal.

Text Development: This committee is responsible for drafting, reviewing, and revising the Basic Manual for the Lawyer's Assistant, the Advanced Manual for the Lawyer's Assistant, and accompanying workbook materials and instructor's materials.

**NALS Foundation Board of Trustees:** The NALS Foundation is an educational foundation dedicated to improving the value of the legal professional through education, research, and other activities. Foundation trustees are responsible for internal and external fundraising and developing collaborative support for its programs. The NALS Foundation funds keynote speakers at educational conferences, awards grants to chapters, states, and regions, and sponsors the Scales of Justice Awards.

The NALS President does not appoint the Foundation Trustees; they are appointed by the Foundation Chair. If you are interested in serving on the Foundation, we will notify the Foundation Chair of your interest.
